We are thankful to our great community for your cooperation and support during our 2-day paving experience. We were pleased with Kinsley's expertise in the paving of our streets. Kinsley kept us well informed which enabled us to get information out to you.

With our narrow streets, they milled the roads the first day allowing you to come and go if necessary. The second day was the hardest part for us because Kinsley needed complete control of our roads in order to finish the paving in one day. We did hear that there were some residents who challenged the workmen and had to be turned back as they tried to leave and/or enter the community too soon. However, the day ended well for us as we were able to return to our homes, if you were parked in one of our off-location areas, at 7 o'clock Wednesday evening.

Note: Every 3 years we have seal coated our roads. Having our roads paved this year means we will not seal coat the roads until 2025.

Annual Summer Inspection

The summer inspection (ASI) will be performed by the Board the first week of June. The following areas to be inspected this year are:

1. Mold on the units, decks and patios
2. Weeds in the mulch beds
3. Overgrowth of shrubs above front windows
4. Driveways are seal coated. We will also check if any driveway is in need of repair and notify you. (See rule #8)

Please inspect your units for potential violations and make the necessary corrections. Mold may need to be treated chemically and/or power washed.

Driveway Permits

The Board just recently found out that permits are required for all new driveways, repaving of existing, widening, or any other similar work completed on existing driveways. No permit is required for driveway seal coating.

Lawn Mowing

It's always a good sign that spring has arrived when we hear the sound of the lawn mowers. We resumed grass cutting on Tuesday, April 26th, one week behind our normal schedule due to Kinsley's Road paving on April 19th. Deer Ridge (our new Landscaping Company) did a great job. We believe everything went smoothly. Occasionally, Deer Ridge will return to do extra work around the common areas, such as, tree trimming, top soil and seeding of bare spots.

Rose bushes planted in the mulch beds have been added to our TVAS approved list of suggested plants.
