ASI

The summer inspection (ASI) will be performed by the Board and Joy Jackson, from CAM, the week of June 5, 2023.

The following areas to be inspected are:

- 1. Foundations that need painting due to peeling, fading, cracking, etc. The last foundation inspection was in 2015.
- 2. Mold on siding, decks, steps and patios
- 3. Overgrown shrubs above front windows
- 4. Weeds in front and side mulch beds

Once inspections are completed, CAM will send violation letters to those affected. Unit owners will be given six (6) weeks to correct the violations. Please refer to Rule 29 for further information.

Green front doors – Foundation color is <u>Duron Master Desert Sand</u> Blue front doors - Foundation color is <u>Cameo 2AC</u> Red front doors - Foundation color is <u>Master Pebblestone Clay</u>

Lawn Damage

To prevent vehicle damage to our grass, we are requesting that cars, trailers and trucks not park on the grass. No exceptions. This includes visitors to your home.

Dryer Vents

It was brought to our attention by a resident about the outside dryer vents that may not have protective covers on them. It is important that you check your vents to make sure birds are not using them for their birdhouses. Clogging up pipes with branches, leaves, and flammable materials is a fire hazard waiting to happen.

Pop-up Drains

For those who may not be familiar with this term, pop-up drains are located in the lawn in front of your house. It is important that they are kept clear of debris and overgrown grass. Clogging of the downspout and drain could result in water in your basement. If you are not familiar with pop-up drains or can't locate them due to overgrown grass or are missing the drain covers, please let the Board know through a call to CAM.
