CANDIDATES

Pre-Election Session Guidelines

This meeting takes place within one week after October 31st, if one candidate request such a forum.

- 1. Introduction of candidates.
- 2. Residents can ask questions about candidates resume or any community related question you want a candidate's response.
- 3. Goal of this meeting is for you to get to know each candidate.
- 4. There will be an optional two (2) minute opening statement from the candidates.
- 5. This is a forum only, not a debate.
- 6. Each candidate will be interviewed one at a time within a 15-minute time frame.
- 7. The interview of each candidate will be conducted in alphabetical order.
- 8. To preserve time, there will be one question allowed per resident per candidate.
- 9. If you have already asked a question, priority will go to someone who has not asked any questions.
- 10. Spouses or family members of the candidates being interviewed are excluded from asking questions of the candidate. Only a resident not in the family shall ask a question.
- 11. The resident will have one (1) minute to ask his/her question.
- 12. The candidate will be given two minutes to respond to the question.
- 13. The moderator will stop the candidate, if the candidate strays from the question.
- 14.Once the forum is over, ballots will be mailed to each unit owner the next business day.
